ZULU ADVENTURE begins as you're greeted at the Johannesburg International Airport and escorted to your Durban flight. On arrival at Durban you'll be transferred to the historic Oyster Box Private Hotel located on the absolute beachfront at Umhlanga. Shaped by early Colonial settlers, indigenous Zulu and Indians who arrived as indentured labourers in the nineteenth Century, Durban is a city of fascinating contrasts and the Gateway to Zululand.

For five days you'll explore the city, immerse yourself in the diverse local culture, banter with herbalists, spice merchants

and fortune tellers in the Indian Market, get within 50 metres of frolicking whales and dolphins, visit the Valley of a Thousand Hills, explore the scenic Natal Midlands and marvel at the dramatic beauty of the Oribi Gorge.

ZULU ADVENTURE turns wild as you head north from Umhlanga towards Pongola near the border of Swaziland. The road follows the rhino, elephant and hippo paths that became linked with human footpaths through the aeons. This glorious untamed territory was once King Shaka's private hunting ground and is home to the black mane lion.

You'll stay for three exhilarating days at a luxurious Private Game Lodge located on one of South Africa's most spectacular private Game Reserves at the foot of the majestic Lebombo Mountains. Protected by your personal Game Ranger you'll

track "the big 5" including lions, leopards, buffalo, rhino and elephants plus cheetah, hippo, giraffe, antelope, all the animals of the region and over 400 species of bird life.



Soaking up the history

ZULU ADVENTURE becomes drenched in history as you move deeper into Zululand and relocate to the world-renowned Fugitives Drift Private Lodge sited on actual Anglo Zulu battlefields.

For two enthralling days and nights you'll experience chilling re-enactments of the Anglo Zulu war of 1879 and enjoy sundowners around the fire with mystical Isandlwana looming on the skyline. This area is full of exciting stories and spectacular scenery and expert guides will have you engrossed in the events that took place more than 128 years ago.

The defeat at Isandlwana, where 24000 Zulu impis almost wiped out an entire regiment in less than an hour, shook the British establishment to its very foundations. South Africa's most famous battle however was at Rorke's Drift where less than 130 British soldiers held off 4000 Zulus for twelve hours. The Victoria Cross was awarded to eleven courageous men and the story of this epic struggle was captured forever in ZULU, the unforgettable and immensely popular movie starring Michael Caine.

The mighty Drakensberg Mountains... breathtaking

ZULU ADVENTURE switches to the visually spectacular as you travel from Fugitives Drift to what is arguably the most magnificent World Heritage site on the planet. The route to the Drakensberg Mountains is one of the few remaining areas where local Zulu people can still be seen in traditional dress. Home to South Africa's earliest inhabitants, known as the Bushmen, the Drakensberg Mountains provide a stunning gallery for rock paintings that date back over 2000 years.

From the massive basalt cliffs of its northern reaches to the soaring sandstone buttresses in the south, the Berg as it's

popularly known offers unsurpassed grandeur and the world's second highest waterfall.

Just 5km from your accommodation at the Champagne Castle Mountain Resort you'll witness over 170 species of birds of prey including the Bearded Vulture and the Black Eagle. To see these birds in flight is a sight not to be missed. The uniqueness of the Drakensberg experience is heightened when the internationally acclaimed Drakensberg Boys Choir gather to entertain you from their misty mountain campus.



Exclusions

The ZULU ADVENTURE tour does not include airfares to and from Durban, drinks nor any expenditure of a personal nature.

Luggage

Luggage is only limited by the requirements of the airline being used by the Client.

The weather and what to wear

Weather conditions for the period September to November are usually mild to warm. It can be cold in mountains and cool when on the evening Game drives. Casual dress during the day is acceptable (including shorts) and smart casual at night.
